SUBJECT: 2019 Illinois State Fair Bone-in Ham, Bacon, Snack Sticks, Beef Jerky, and Smoked/Cooked Brat Show

The 2019 Illinois State Fair is just around the corner and we are looking to show off what Illinois Processors have to offer! Fire up those smokehouses and bring your A-game as we sift through hams, bacon, snack sticks, beef jerky, and smoked/cooked brats for the best-of-the-best.

We have five classes this year with the newly added smoked/cooked brats category, along with: commercial bone-in ham, commercial bacon, snack sticks, and beef jerky. Competition is open to all meat processors who process hams, bacon, smoked/cooked brats, snack sticks, and beef jerky. Exhibitors are limited to one entry per class, and all entries must be properly labeled.

- Hams can be of any weight and will consist of one class only -- light cured, commercial bone-in style:---This class shall be a mildly cured ham, may or may not be tenderized, and consists principally of pumped hams which require refrigeration.
- Commercial bacon can be of any weight and will likewise consist of only one class. They can have the rind either on or off, but must be cured or smoked.
- Beef jerky may be made from any cut of **beef**. All jerky must be adequately dried, to meet the required moisture/protein ratio of 75:1 or less. Excessively "wet" product will be downgraded or disqualified. Jerky must be made from one whole piece of meat. One half pound of jerky is required for submission.
- Snack sticks must be made from beef, pork, buffalo, lamb, veal, poultry, seafood or any combination of those. This product must be a traditional type meat snack stick and **cannot contain specialty non-meat ingredients or flavorings**.
- Smoked/cooked brats must be fully cooked. May contain additional ingredients. Additional ingredients will be subject to judging of distribution and uniformity (i.e. cheese and it's even distribution throughout the product).

The meat display will be at the Illinois Department of Agriculture Display tent east of the coliseum again this year. Additional cooler space is available this year, so we need your participation to "fill" the coolers. The meats display will include the Illinois State Fair competition entries, winners of the 2019 IAMP Product Show (held in Bloomington, Illinois), a variety of retail products, a display board of the 2019 Innovative contest winners, and a map of IAMP operator members. All products (competition and display products) must be at Turasky's by Noon on Wednesday, August 7. The entry form will be due Thursday August 1, 2019.

Judging will take place at the Illinois Department of Agriculture Tent at 1:00 p.m. on Saturday, August 10, 2019. **Each plant that enters a product in the Processed Meat Show will be eligible to bring two specialty products to display in the meats display during the Illinois State Fair. The specialty products should be packaged for display as if they were in your own plant. The products will be displayed in one of the refrigerated coolers and should be able to maintain shelf life for the entire duration of the fair.** A Commodities Auction will be held for the winners of each category on Tuesday, August 13th at 4:00 p.m. in the Coliseum. The Champion Ham, Bacon, Snack Sticks, Beef Jerky, and Smoked/Cooked Brat will be sold at the Auction with proceeds going to the Sleeter Bull Scholarship Fund, a fund designed to aid the study of meat science at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign.

I hope you plan to participate and make the 2019 Illinois State Fair Show the largest and most successful to date!
